Baie dankie vir al die gelukwensinge vir my en die Raad, veral vanaf lede wat nie op die jaarvergadering was nie. Ek beskou dit as my plig om sake wat vorige jare nie aandag geniet het te ondersoek en oplossings daarvoor te vind. Van die belangrikste sake is die Keuring van perde en die daarstelling van 'n Kursus waardeur Keurders en Beoordelaars suksessvol opgelei kan word.

6. Breeder Focus

Genootskapslede word hier aan die groter Percheron gemeenskap bekendgestel.

After writing 3 articles and thinking a great deal about them I have decided to keep it short and sweet with a few photos.

Our horses are different here on Outeniqua Moon and our attitude to breeding is totally different from the majority of the breeders. We look on them as Equine Gods whom we have the privilege of custodianship. This is why our horses fetch such high prices, because we value

them so highly. It is all very well attaching a materialistic value to a horse, but it is the esteem with which the animal is held and treated which gives weight to the value. Our stud is small with 12 Percherons in total and 4 other horses. 2 of the Percherons don't belong to us. We have the most ideal ambient climate here so stabling is not really necessary and after losing a beloved mare to colic we have abandoned our stables and are ruggering them up in winter when it is cold or wet. (98% of colic cases occur in stabled horses) The camps are arranged around our house so none of the horses are more than 10 minutes walk away. The stallion, Greystoke sleeps opposite our bedroom window. First thing in

the morning we (Peter and I) walk round our horses and talk to each and every one of them and find out if they are alright. Then we feed them and we stay with them whilst they are eating so that there are no squabbles over food

And each horse can eat its food in peace. We feed Lucerne, teff, a concentrate and Equivita as a vitamin supplement, we feed the milking mares and the stallion 3 times a day and the others get fed 2 times a day. The foals and growing horses get the most. The last check we do on the horses personally is around 10 at night and we go to each and every horse and talk to them.

We handle our foals from birth and I have never missed a foaling. We move in with our mares when they are foaling and help the foals onto the teat. We stay with our mares for up to a month (we camp in the field). All this attention makes for a fantastic temperament. The foals lay with their heads on laps and still do so when they are grown up.

We check hooves on a daily basis and the foals are trained in the first week to pick up their hooves. We do our own trims every 3 weeks and our horses are sprayed regularly for ticks with Bayticol. We de-worm 4 times a year and sometimes more if need be. They are always inoculated against African Horse Sickness every year.

Once a year the horse dentist comes around and pulls out wolf teeth and rasps all the horses teeth. Seeing the dentist once a year makes a huge difference to the condition of the horse and can save as much as 20% on food that would not otherwise be digested.

The way we handle and love our horses ensures wonderful temperaments with out vices and completely trusting. This is the secret and the key to all good horses. Horses that are beaten and messed about haven't much of a chance and generally end up dangerous. Our horses are taught to interact with gentleness, respect and love. When we back our horses for the first time they smile. We teach our horses to pull a cart and be ridden. Our horses are taught to obey voice commands and are not at all spooky.

When we do sell a horse we do so to selected buyers whom we can be sure as we possibly can, will love and care for them for their whole lives.


We knew we were moving to South Africa in two years time so we
